At Fletching Church in Sassex, three generations of Churchills meet. With their parents are two-year-eld Richelas Seemes - Winsten's grandson - and two-menths-eld Hama Mary Seemes - about to be christened. Mrs. Demoan Sandys - is with two more of the Churchill grandchildren - nine-year-eld Häwina and four-year-eld Delia Mary. Mr. Duncan Sandys was a former Minister of Works in Mr. Churchill's Government. Accompanying the eld werrier, are his wife and his son Randelph.

Mearly all Fletching crowds the entrance to the little parioh church at the end of the service. They've come to wish luck to the mixth Churchill grandchild - Rome Mary Scames - first daughter of the former Miss Mary Churchill, who was her father's travelling companion during many of his war-time travels.
