## LIVERPOOL £2,000,000 DOCK BLAZE

Flames, sheeting up hundreds of feet, light Liverpeel's night sky, as an uncontrollable blase sweeps a 400-yard-long dock warehouse.

After a twenty-few-hour battle, the still-fiercely burning fire is brought under control. Dosens of fleats and fire brigades from all over Northern England have managed to confine the blase and have saved the dock railway and several acres of timber yards. The damage, including less of expert cargoes, is set at two million pounds. A coating of liquid rubber now covers the water and 12 firemen have been injured by the melten stream.

The Home Office is to hold an inquiry into the cause of the fire, which may go on burning for several days.
