JET ROCKER TAKES THE AIR

From America comes the new three-jet bender. Jets one and two are below the cockpit - number three is in the tail. It also carries a parashute to ensure that it doesn't overshoet the runway. Designed to support ground troops, the NB51 now takes off on its maiden flight.

The designers of this triple-jet claim speeds of 600-miles-an-hour. The parachute brake, for optional use by the pilet, is mainly intended for landing on short ranways.

From the U.S. Navy comes the "loca" - a buss-bomb based on a submarine. In a naval exercise off Hawaii, the first bomb is launched. Owing to a technical fault it plunges into the sea.
