

SERETSE KHAMA COMES IN FROM AFRICA

Southampton's Marine Airport spells "journey's end" to a 6,000 mile flight from Africa. Coming in from Bechuanaland, Seretse Khama, 27-year-old chief-designate of the Bamangwato tribe. He had been summoned to Britain to discuss the future rulership of the tribe - affected by his marriage to former London typist Ruth Williams. Authority turns out to meet him with everything short of an iron curtain. Special branch officers convey him to London. To reporters, Seretse gives a half-smile and "No comment." The former Oxford law student hopes that his visit will end the deadlock over the future chieftainship of his 100,000 subjects.
