NAVAL EXPLOSION - SABOTAGE?

Pighting ships of the silent service ride undamaged in Pertsmouth harbour (among them an aircraft carrier) following the explosion which destroyed nine lighters leading amounttion at Bedenham pier. Although damage was widespread it would have been greater but for three engine-drivers who hauled forty amounttion trucks clear. Evidence uncovered by careful search points to sabetage - culmination of fifty major and minor incidents in two years. The question now being asked is: was a thermite bomb sunggled on board? The amountion was for British ships fighting for the United Mations in Korean waters. Severe damage was done to other vessels at anchor. Sabetage or not, Britain must safeguard all supplies for themen who man her ships.
