the Minister of Fuel and Power for the opening of a new coke oven
plant.

To inspect the huge plant the Duke puts on an overall. Coal, is fed by charging cars into these evens. After cocking or carbonising for 15 hours the resultant coke is pushed out. During the treatment gas and a host of hyproducts are extracted from which mylem, saccharine, dyes, disinfectants and the like are made. This plant can handle 1000 tens of coal a day.

The coles car takes its still burning coles under the quenching tower where 5000 gallens of water puts it out in a minute. The coles is then spread to dry and coel, and, after grading, begins its last journey to the consumer. What happens to all the goodness extracted is another story.
