AVALANCHE KILLS 12

Piled high over Airele in South Switmerland a huge mass of snow, ice and debris lessens under rain and gales and everwhelms the little term in the dark of night. With 15 feet of snow in their streets, the few people left begin to dig out. Before the threat of the 200-yard wide avalanche the 2,000 pepulation, 500 treeps and cattle had been evasuated. But some remained, too old or unwilling to move. In 12 minutes the little term was buried under hundreds of tens of snow and reeks, and when they teek count, 12 were dead.

The whole of South-cast Switzerland is threatened as snow continues. The St. Gothard tunnel, main route to Italy, is cut again, and some mountain roads are buried 100 foot deep. Despite all man's skill, nature is still untamed.
