

ENGLAND V. SCOTLAND

England tackle Scotland in the 68th match between the two countries and 30-thousand from North of the border rear as the brilliant Scottish line gets swiftly into action and Johnstone slams in a shot that nearly beats Williams. England are favourites but it's all Scotland so far, with the fast forwards tearing gaps down the centre. England haven't won at Wembley since 1934; and here's Williams hard tested again. It's a corner. Waddell takes the kick. The Rangers winger sends over a good 'un. This looks dangerous for England. But the ball's cleared up field. It's a high one. Liddell and Mannion jump for it; there's a collision and they're both down; and they're staying there. Liddell's all right, though, but it's a shock for England as Mannion's carried off with a fractured cheek-bone, and out of the match.

Now here's Billy Steele starting a Scottish attack; the Dundee man passes inside to Johnstone; but the Hibs. wonder-boy is beaten by Williams, who clears.

At the other end Mortenson gets the ball and passes to Hassall. The 22-year-old Huddersfield forward makes a dashing run; he shoots and puts England one up in his first international.

Eight minutes later and Scotland pressing. Waddell passes to Evans, who kicks forward. Over comes a Billy cross and Johnstone slams in the equalizer.

One all at half-time, Scotland are now pressing for the lead. They missed several chances in the first half but England's ten men have played like a team and a half.

From a nice movement between Liddell and Steele, Steele runs on and passes; Billy bursts through and shoots and it's Scotland 2, England 1.

Redpath throws in. It's returned and he passes up field to Steele. The Dundee man steadies himself and sends over a high centre. Williams runs out and intercepts - but he's fumbled it and the ball's on the ground. Outside-left Liddell sees a chance. It's an open goal and he shoots!

Scotland 3, England 1. Blackpool captain Johnstone passes to Matthews and the wizard, who's played a grand game centres. Finney is there and shoots, but the ball just skims the goal. It's grand the way this England team of ten are fighting. Here's another attack Finney makes a brilliant sole run; Cowan comes out but the ball's in the net; but that's the end and Scotland win the championship.
