11 AM. RIVIERA CUT OFF BY FLOODS.
PARIS, SATURDAY:

THE FRENCH RIVIERA WAS ALMOST COMPLETELY ISOLATED FOR OVER 36 HOURS FOLLOWING HEAVY RAINS. NICE WAS ESPECIALLY CUT OFF OWING TO TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPHIC WIRES BEING DESTROYED. TRAINS WERE STOPPED AND AIRFIELDS WERE UNDER WATER. DAMAGE IS REPORTED TO BE EXTENSIVE BUT NO CASUALTIES OCCURRED.

11 1 AM. FIREMAN PLAN LONDON MARCH.
THE FIRE BRIGADES UNION ANNOUNCES TODAY THAT FIREMEN FROM ALL OVER BRITAIN WILL MARCH THROUGH LONDON ON MONDAY AFTERNOON AS A DEMONSTRATION IN SUPPORT OF THEIR REPRESENTATIVES, WHO WILL BE MEETING LOCAL AUTHORITIES THE FOLLOWING DAY (TUESDAY) TO DISCUSS A CLAIM FOR THE RESOTRATION OF EQUALITY OF PAY WITH THE POLICE.

DELEGATES FROM EVERY BRIGADE IN THE COUNTRY, NUMBERING 300 MEN, WILL ARRIVE IN LONDON ON MONDAY, FOR AN EMERGENCY NATIONAL DELEGATE CONFERENCE AT THE ROYAL HOTEL, WOBURN PLACE, EUSTON, STARTING AT 11 AM. WHICH WILL BE ADDRESSED BY MR JOHN HORNER, GENERAL SECRETARY OF THE 19,000 STRONG FIRE BRIGADES UNION.

AFTER THE CONFERENCE THE DELEGATES, JOINED BY OVER 100 FIREMEN FROM LONDON AND HOME COUNTRIES BRIGADES, WILL MARCH BEHIND SMALL BANNERS SHOWING THE NAMES OF BRIGADES REPRESENTED FROM EUSTON TO HYDE PARK WHERE THEY WILL HOD AN OPEN AIR MEETING. SOME WIVES HAVE ASKED THE UNION'S PERMISSION TO MARCH WITH THEIR HUSBANDS.
