POPE HAVES NEW SATIFFS

In St. Peter's, Home, standard, representing three who are to be named saints, are followed by the Papal procession from the Sistine Chapel. In full camenical dress, Pope Pius III comes to raise three good men to the glery of the alters in this coremony of canonization.

The three new saints are Francesco Rianchi, Antonio Gianeli and Ignamic da Laceni; and in Laceni in Sardinia from the Church of St. Anne they carry the body of St. Ignamic in procession to honour his canonization. Bern just 250 years ago, he devoted his life to the service of the poor and the sinner Sardinia. After the procession the body returns to its place on honour in the village church.

So today, in St. Peter's, the Catholic Church gives its highest honour.

Now comes the moment as His Holiness prensumes the decree of canonisation which places his Church's seal on the service of three good men.
