

4. TRAPPED BY CAVE-IN

At Woodstock, Ontario, volunteers dig desperately to save Carl Springstead, buried up to his neck. He, with four others, was buried under tons of wet earth when caught in a cave-in while trying to rescue a fourth man, trapped in an earlier fall. A human chain is organised to haul Springstead out from under the earth, and after hours of burial, Springstead, a fireman, is carried in a basket-litter to safety. He suffered no serious injury.

Other rescuers are here being hauled to safety. This one is luckier than the first victim, whom he was trying to rescue. For David Smart, whose body is recovered after twenty-four hours under the earth, rescue comes too late.

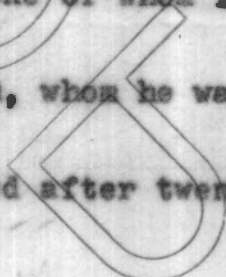
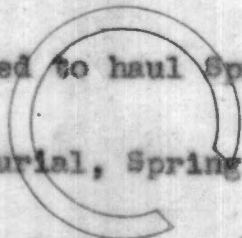
