KOJE PRISCHERS DEFT BRITISH

Red prisemers raise abusive banners in Koje Island compounds, in defiance of United Nations orders, even as British and Canadian troops are brought in to reinforce the garrison. Marine General Beatner, the new American caup commander, warns the British that the prisemers still do much as they please and continue to defy regulations by marching in a kind of Oriental geose-step, singing, shouting, and even engaging in bayenet-practise with makeshift wooden rifles. It may take several weeks before all the prisemers can be split into more manageable groups. Meanwhile, there have been fierce clashes in compound seventy-six between the Reds and their American guards, resulting in a heavy death-roll.
