X On Kojé Island, rebellious Red prisoners, raising insulting and abusive manners in their compounds in defiance of U.N. orders, continue to act much as they please. British and Canadian troops sent to reinforce the garrison are briefed by the new camp commander, Marine General Beatner. Beatner warns them that the U.N. still is not in control within the compounds.

X Meanwhile the Communist P.O.W.'s defy regulations by marching in what looks like a kind of Oriental goose-step, singing, shouting, and engaging in bayonet practice with makeshift wooden rifles. Beatner says that it will take several weeks before more fences can be built, to split the prisoners into manageable groups. Until then, they take orders--not from General Beatner, but from Moscow.
