

ITALY WINS AT SILVERSTONE

Line-up for the Grand Prix. That's Prince Bira in a Gordini; Reg Parnell, Cooper-Bristol; next comes Ascari, favourite in his Ferrari; Farina in another and Taruffi in a third. But now it's time for the start.

Eighty-five laps to go - about 249 miles - and the Ferraris get out to make it a pillar-to-post dash, as Taruffi shoots past Farina.

Here's Downing in a Connaught.

And here's Stirling Moss (B.R.A), leading Collins, but Ascari's well clear of the field - he's a whole lap ahead of Taruffi, with Mike Hawthorn third in his Cooper-Bristol, as Ascari's Ferrari wins with an average speed of just under 91-miles-an-hour! A triumph for the Ferraris. Goldie Gardner watches as the Victorious Italian steps forward to receive his prize from the Honourable Max Aitken.
