

Visit of Her Royal Highness, The Princess Margaret, Commandant-in-Chief, St. John Ambulance Brigade Cadets, to Worcester, 26th. July 1952.

Her Royal Highness, The Princess Margaret, will attend a rally of some 3,000 St. John Cadets at the race course, Worcester, on 26th. July. The event begins at 2.30. p.m., ends at 4.p.m.

In the morning, Princess Margaret will be taking part in an Enrolment Ceremony for Cadets at Shirehall, Worcester. She will arrive at Shirehall at 11.45 and leave at 12.30.

A Civic Lunch is being held at the Guildhall.

For the Shirehall ceremony the 'rota' system of representation will be operated. Buckingham Palace Passes will be issued to a special press party, and applications for inclusion in this party should be addressed, in the case of the National Press, to the Newspaper Proprietors Association and, in the case of the Provincial Press, to the Newspaper Society.

At the rally the following areas will be represented by Cadets:- Worcester (440), Birmingham (560), Hereford (282), Shropshire (207) Warwickshire (287), Gloucestershire (295), Staffordshire (600), Oxford (100), Northants (139), Derbyshire (64), Leicestershire (6) Hampshire (29), Surrey (22) and Wales.

In the event of rain in the afternoon the event will be held in the following:-

Public Hall: Birmingham and Northamptonshire Ambulance and Nursing Cadets. (Ambulance Cadets are boys; Nursing Cadets, girls)

Worcester Royal Grammar School: Ambulance Cadets from Herefordshire, Staffordshire, Gloucestershire, Shropshire, Warwickshire, Derbyshire, Leicestershire, Oxfordshire, Wales.

Alice Ottley School: Nursing Cadets from the areas in preceding paragraph plus those from Hampshire.

Shirehall: Ambulance and Nursing Cadets from Worcestershire and Surrey. Princess Margaret will deliver her address here.


In the event of wet weather, photography in the various halls etc. will be on the 'rota' system.
