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After two weeks of national mourning, the body of Eva Peron, wife of Argentine ~~skkkt~~ dictator Juan Peron, is carried through the streets of Buenos ~~skkkt~~ Aires. High government officials accompany it through crowds which stretch as far as the eye can see. A float bears huge replicas of Eva's hands. Many of these people have waited twelve and fifteen hours to see the casket, despite rains and bitterly cold winds blowing from the pampas. Columns of workers pull the catafalque. Eva's body will be placed in a special chapel in the headquarters of the General Labor Confederation while the public contributes to and immense and elaborate mausoleum in her memory.
