## £9,000,000 OIL REFINERY

Twenty million pounds have been spent since the war on the huge petroleum refinery at Stenlew, Cheshire, which covers an area of two-and-a-half square miles. This is where eight millions of it went. It's a new plant where more than two million gallons of high octane fuel are produced weekly by a system called "catalytic gracking." The Flant, known as a "cat-cracker, needs only eight men to work it.

because, fuel gas, bitumen, and chemicals used in paints, perfume and medicines from this Stanlow plant. And their sulphur production (40 tens of it a day) is doing much to relieve the country's serious shortage of this valuable commodity. Now that the "cat-cracking" plant is in action, this and other refineries are pressing the government to return to the pre-mer branded petrols. If they succeed, the days of pool petrol may be numbered.
