Roll one. Beginning of Roll shots showing the Duchess of Kent with Gov of Sarawak at the Governor's residence.

Arrival of H.R.H. and the Duke at Jesselton, where H.R.H. was met by the Governor of North Borneo Sir Ralph Hone, after which H.R.H. inspected the guard of honour consisting the North Borneo constables, ~~KRAKAKAHRADAN~~ KAAMERI and then H.R.H. was introduced to the V.I.P.s of Jesselton.  
Roll Two - Arrival of H.R.H. the Duchess of Kent at the Teachers training college near Jesselton which she declared open the college. Shots showing various parts of the college.

Roll Three - same as above. Shots showing H.R.H. stopping at Mengestel village to speak to some of the villagers and also shots of schoolchildren with Union Jack to welcome H.R.H.

Roll Four - shots showing the Duchess of Kent at the tea party in Jesselton where she was introduced to several V.I.P. of Jesselton and at the same time various types of welcome dances were performed by various communities in Jesselton.

Roll Five - the same as above.

Roll Six - shots showing the Duke of Kent going hunting when he was touring N. Borneo. The hunting took place at a village which is about 45 miles from Jesselton named (Kota Belut) the hunting was not very successful. (The Duke goes hunting riding a horse for about 3 hours).

Roll Seven - Shots showing the Duke at the Bazaar accompanied by the District Officer Mr. Chisholm of Kota Belut. after which the Duke saw cock fighting at the Bazaar.

Roll Eight - Beginning of Roll, shots of the Duke being escorted by horsemen at Kota Belut (after the hunting trip returning to Jesselton). Rest of Roll's shots showing the Duchess opening a new hospital at Sandakan, the Hospital is named after the Duchess of Kent.

DUCHESS OF KENT VISITS BRUNEI.

1st October, 1952.

Location - Brunei.

Roll One. - Photo showing H.H. Duchess of Kent and the Duke arriving at the custom sharp at Brunei and were met by the Sultan of Brunei and the British Resident, H.M.A. the Duchess of Kent and H.H. the Sultan of Brunei then entered the State Litter and being carried by 22 Balays personal bodyguard, carrying sword, spears and shields and proceeded to the Council chamber.

At the Council Chamber H.H. the Duchess of Kent was presented with an address of welcome enclosed in a elaborate case of Brunei Silver work of which the local people of Brunei are noted for.
