Arriving by plane from London, last week with his wife OONA, Charlie Chaplin alights in Orly Field, where a heavy police cordon is ready to protect them from a crowd of fans and reporters.

Next day, Charlie Chaplin and his wife receive in their room at the Ritz Hotel in Paris, a delegation of Theater Managers who offer Oona Chaplin a collection of Hermes' most lovely scarves, as a souvenir

And in the afternoon of the same day, Charlie Chaplin receives the Legion of Honor from the hands of Mr. André Marie, French Minister of Arts. This ceremony took place at the Center of the Society des Auteurs, in the presence of Theater and Motion pictures leading personalities among which we see René Clair famous French producer.

President and Madame Vincent AURIOL honored both MOLIERE and "CHARLOT" when he went to a Gala given at the famous COMEDIE FRANCAISE for Charlie Chaplin and his wife Cona.

All the comedians of the Comedie Francaise troupe were present as well as all famous names of the Motion Picture and theater world and Moliere's SAGANARELLE was played on the set.

A crowd gathered in front of the Comedie Francaise to watch arrival of all Paris' personalities in full dresses and attire.

after arrival of President and Madame Auriol, Charlie Chaplin and his wife arrive at the Comedie Francaise. They are greeted in the famous FOYER, by the President and Madame Auriol who shake hands with Charlie and Cona and chat familiarly before going to their respective balcony seats.

In the theater room are all French loveliest artists, Jacqueline Delubac, Micheline Presle and Renee Saint Cyr, .....etc.

Between parts, Charlie Chaplin goes over to President Auriol's places, and then visits the Comedians in the Foyer. Debucourt is acting as Don Juan, and Fernand Ledoux as Saganarelle. Even if he does not understand french very well, Charlie Chaplin seems to like the act.

At the end of the Gala, Charlie Chaplin, seats in Moliere's own chair before signing the ~~Red~~ Gold Book of the ancient Theater: la Comedie Francaise, founded by Moliere.
