This ceremony took place at the Center of the Society des Auteurs, in the presence of Theater and Motion pictures leading personalities among which we see René Clair famous French producer.

A crowd gathered in front of the Comedie Francaise to watch arrival of all Paris' personnalities in full dresses and attire.

after arrival of President and Madame Auriol, Charlie Chaplin and his wife arrive at the Comedie Francaise. They are greated in the famous FOYER, by the President and Madame Auriol who shake hands with Charlie and Come and that familiarly before going to their respective balcomy seats.

In the theater room are all French loveliest artists, Jacqueline Delubac, Micheline Presle and Rence Saint Cyr, ....etc.

Between parts, Charlie Chaplin goes over to President Auriol's places, and then visits the Comedians in the Foyer. Debucourt is acting as Don Juan, and Fernand Ledoux as Saganarelle. Even if he does not understand french very well, Charlie Chaplin seems to like the act.
