

TEMPLER OPENS FACTORY

A great new factory, just outside Kuala Lumpur, is opened by General Sir Gerald Templer, the High Commissioner and Commander in Chief of the Federation of Malaya. The factory will produce soap, glycerine, edible oils and fats. The total output of finished products is expected to be between fifteen and twenty thousand tons a year. Malaya herself will supply nearly all the raw materials.

More than 700 of the men and women to be employed here will be Malaysians and, Sir Gerald Templer reveals that plans are already being prepared to give specialised training to young Malaysians to help them reach high administrative positions in the factory.
