MIG BORDER INCIDENT

Even as the wreckage of an American Sabre Jet shot down in Germany by two MIGs, is examined, there comes news that another MIG has shot down an R.A.F. Lincoln, killing her crew of six. Lieutenant Brown, on the right, is the pilot of the American jet who managed to bale out before the crash. The MIGs, which have been making the headlines since these attacks, are not faring so well in combat in Korea. United Nations jet fighters are taking a heavy toll of them in the skies over the battle zone. Cameras record some of the kills.

At ten miles a minute, United Nations pilots are tracking down and destroying the best pilots the enemy can put into the air.
