GENERAL TEMPLER REOPENS EAST COAST RAILWAY.

After twelve long years, a train rumbles across Malaya to the East Boast and General Templer is at the controls.

Christened the Golden Blowpipe, it stopped fifteen times for The Righ Commissioner to call at villages on route. At a gutta Percha plantation, the only one of its kind of commercial importance in the Commonwealth, a Malay woman chops off the leaves from which it is extracted.

The General talked to Malays and Chinese villagers. Early in 1942 all bridges were blown up to stop the Japanese invaders. Communists terrerism hindered its reconstruction but now in General Templer's words it is a "cataloade of confidence in Malaya's future".
