IRAN - SHAH RETURNS IN TRIUMPH.

Crown Prince Abdullah greets the Shah as he landed at Bagdad Airport after a seven-hour flight from Rome. Here he was to remain overnight as the guest of King Feisal before completing the journey to Teheran.

Meanwhile, in Teheran itself all stood ready to welcome the return of the Shah after the dramatic development in events which first compelled him to flee, and then led to a Royalist Coup d'etat in which Mossadeq was arrested.
