SEPTEMBER 21, 1953.

SS "GREENVILLE" OF THE WORLDWIDE SS CO. FROM MONROVIA (REPUBLIC
OF LIBERIA).

MASTER DIMITRIOS POTAMINOS WAS CARRYING A 9,000 TON CARGO OF
WHEAT FROM MONTREAL TO LIVERPOOL.

During the storm 85 M/H

During the rescue 30 M/H

WAVES:

During the storm 50 feet.

During the rescue 20 feet.

BAROMETRIC PRESSURE:

First S.O.S. heard at 3.55 PM G.M.T on Sept. 20, 1953.

Spotted on radar screen at 308 AM GMT (14 nautical miles that is 16 miles).

Reached at about 4.15 AM GMT on Sept 21st.

From 1 P.M. to 6 P.M. on Sept. 21st 1953.

1 Whale boat making 3 trips.

1st trip rescued 5.

2nd trip rescued 6.

3rd trip rescued 1.

1 motor boat trip- 1 trip rescued 12.
rescuers 30 men.

"Greenville" crew was 26 men.

Rescued: 24

Dead before arrival: 1 (first officer)

Drowned 1 (Nanshey 19 years old)
