

SIR WINSTON HOME AGAIN.

The B.O.A.C. Stratocruiser Canopus returns to London Airport from Bermuda, following the Big Three Conference, with Sir Winston Churchill and French Premier Joseph Laniel aboard. Travelling with them are Mr. Eden and other members of the British and French delegations which discussed future policies with President Eisenhower and chief American ministers. One of Sir Winston's last actions before he left Bermuda was to assure the islanders that British troops would again take up garrison there. Sir Miles Thomas, Chairman of B.O.A.C., and other officials greet the Premier.

Lady Churchill is still in Sweden where she received the Nobel Prize on behalf of Sir Winston, but Mr. Butler, Chancellor of the Exchequer, is among those who are at the airport to say "Welcome Home, Sir Winston"
