PRIVATE TALKS TO PRIVATE KELLY.

At London Airport, a ~~British~~ unit prepares to fly to Hanover to meet Private Kelly, whose story of Russian imprisonment has made headline news. "Sir Francis Bacon", an Elizabethan airliner of British European Airways speeds them on their way. Only a day before, ~~she~~^{A.K.C.} had visited the little house, at Beddwell Road, Forest Hill, where Kelly's mother is preparing to welcome him home. Quickly she wrote a short letter to her son, and gave it with family photographs, to ~~her~~^{OUR} reporter.

This is Private Kelly. At Hanover's military hospital he tells pressmen of the seven years he spent in Soviet prison camps, following his arrest for alleged espionage. The Russians released him suddenly some days ago without explanation. Now Kelly says -

Private Kelly is still under strict medical supervision, for he is obviously overwrought and weak from his captivity. Now ~~her~~^{OUR} reporter hands him his mother's note:

The military authorities hope that Kelly, for the first time in eight years, will be able to spend Christmas at home again.
