Chemistry prize winner is Hermann Staudinger, whose work was described by Professor Fredga.

The prize winner in Bpysiology and Medicine is Professor Hans Adolf Krebs which he shared with Professor Fritz Lipmann of Harvard. Their work was presented by Professor E. Hammersten.

Sir Winston Churchill's work was presented by Br. Sigfrid Siwertz, of the Swedish Academy, who remarked that Lady Clementine Churchill was deputising for her famous husband Sir Winston. She receives the Nobel proze for Literature.

The Ceremony ended with the National Anthem.
