The World famous Olympic Ski-Run at Garmisch in Upper Bavaria draws 18,000 spectators as the first international ski-jumping competition of the season begins. Morway and Pinland are, as, usual, tipped as the winners despite snow conditions very different to theirs at home. But it doesn't take them long to master this most sensitional of runs.

Arnfin Bergmann, a Norwegian champion, makes a mighty jump of about 230 feet.

The slow-motion camera reveals the full grace of an almost perfect jump by Finland's Esko Moemmoe.

Now Olav Bjernstad, another Norwegian takes the air.

And that's the winning jump! - just about 245 feet. A superb example of daring and skill bf one of Norway's greatest sportsman.
