

Egypt's chief auctionmer Mr. G. Lee began on February 12th the auction sale of ex-King Farouk's tweasures at Koubbeh Palace in Cairo.

Farcuk's tremendous stamp collection was the first item to go on the block, and a large part of the most valuable items were bought by Mr. Jacques CASSAB.
