NEGUIB (EXCLUSIVE)

Exclusive pictures from Cairo show the fervent demonstrations which helped restore General Neguib as President of Egypt. Only three days before, members of the Revolution Council, headed by Colonel Nasser, forced him to resign. But public opinion, plus sharp counter-action by sections of the Army put Neguib back in control. At the council's headquarters, Neguib attends a reconciliation meeting with Colonel Nasser and others who toppled him from power. Nasser originally claimed that the whole army was backing the revolt, but officers of the Cavalry regiments denied it, and insisted on Neguib's restoration. Although Neguib is back at the top, hero worship it seems, is not encouraged. Much back-slapping (without a knife this time) has followed the reconciliation of Neguib and Nasser. But riots during Neguib's Sudan visit with "Dancing Major" Salem indicate that Egypt's troubles are not over.
