onest lie fleeded, hit by one of the worst cyclenes Australia has suffered in recent years. Hundreds of roads and railways were completely submerged after winds of gale ferce, and torrential rains, swept across the land. Rivers, swellen by the rain, have devastated many of the richest dairying districts in Australia. Hundreds of livestock have been marcomed - scores have been drowned. In outlaying villages, rescue teams have brought many people to safety; but dozens have yet to be found and it is feared that their names will be added to the death-roal which already stands at 25.

loss during this grievous disaster.
