MR.R.GRAHAM PAGE (C.CROSBY) ASKED THE MINISTER OF TRANSPORT A D CIVIL AVIATION WHETHER HE WOULD INTRODUCE A SPEED LIMIT OF 25 M.P.H. IN A SELECTED TOWN FOR AN EXPERIMENTAL PERIOD.

MR.HUGH MOLSON, PARLIAMENTARY SECRETARY, REPLIED "WHILE INAPPRECIATE THE MOTIVE UNDERLYING THE SUGGESTION, I DON'T THINK IT WOULD SERVE ANY USEFUL PURPOSE. A MAXIMUM SPEED OF 30 M.P.H. HAS BEEN ACCEPTED AS REASONABLE FOR MANY YEARS IN BUILT UP AREAS".

MR.W.KEENAN (LAB.KIRKDALE); "IS HE
AWARE THAT MANY OF THE TOWNS ARE NOW CONCERNED ABOUT THE SPEED LIMIT
THAT IS IN EXISTENCE AND THAT THERE HAS BEEN AN INCREASING NUMBER
OF ACCIDENTS. THE FACT IS THAT THE FASTER THEY GO THE MORE
ACCIDENTS THERE ARE. THERE IS A CASE FOR THE REDUCTION OF SPEED
IN THE TOWNS".

MR.MOLSON: "THE MAJORITY OF ACCIDENTS IN THIS COUNTRY ARE IN THOSE AREAS WHERE THERE IS A SPEED LIMIT".

3.6 PM. LORD MAYOR'S SPEECH.

THE LORD MAYOR, SIR NOEL BOWATER, IN HIS SPEECH SAID THAT IT WAS WITH BOUNDLESS JOY AND GLADNESS THAT THE CITIZENS OF LONDON TODAY CELEBRATED THE TRIUMPHANT RETURN OF THE QUEEN. THE HISTORIC VISIT TO SO MANY REALMS AND TERRITORIES HE DESCRIBED AS "THIS GREAT WORLD ENCIRCLING ENTERPRISE."

IT WAS AN UNDERTAKING, HE SAID, OF UNPRECEDENTED EXTENT AND IMPORTANCE. AS AN ACHIEVEMENT OF INSPIRED CONCEPTION AND BRILLIANT EXECUTION IT WOULD EVER REMAIN A GLITTERING JEWEL IN THE CASKET OF A NATION'S MEMORY.

IT WAS WITH EQUAL ENTHUSIASM THAT THEY WELCOMED HOME THE DUKE OF EDINBURGH WHOSE UNFAILING SUPPORT AND WATCHFUL CARE HAD BEEN THE ADMIRATION OF THEM ALL.

"TOGETHER YOU HAVE MADE A WONDERFUL TEAM" SAID THE LORD MAYOR, "A TEAM WHICH HAS WON THE AFFECTION OF THE PEOPLES OF THE BRITISH COMMONWEALTH IN A WAY THAT HAS NEVER BEEN DONE BEFORE."

THE LORD MAYOR REFERRED TO THE TUMULTOUS GREETINGS BY THOUSANDS OF PERSONS OF DIVERS RACES AT EVERY WALK OF LIFE DURING THE TOUR AND SAID IT HAD BEEN AN IMPRESSIVE CAVALCADE OF EVENTS WHICH THEY AT HOME HAD WATCHED WITH FASCINATED PRIDE.

THE ROYAL VISIT TO HER OTHER COUNTRIES HAD DEEPENED, AS NOTHING ELSE COULD HAVE DONE, THE SENSE THAT THEY WERE ALL ONE FAMILY WITH THE QUEEN AT ITS HEAD.

"YOUR MAJESTY'S GIFT OF ROYAL FRIENDSHIP. INTEREST AND CONSIDERATION FOR OTHERS HAS SET AN EXAMPLE TO THE WHOLE WORLD. IT MIGHT EVEN BE THE HARBINGER OF UNIVERSAL PEACE, FOR NOBILITY OF CHARACTER IS SURELY A LAMP TO ILLUMINE THE DARKEST CORNERS OF THE EARTH."

SIR NOEL SAID HE WAS PROUD AND HONOURED AS LORD MAYOR TO OFFER ON BEHALF OF THE CORPORATION AND THE CITIZENS OF LONDON THEIR HUMBLE DUTY AND HOMAGE.

M THE POLLOWING IS THE TEXT OF THE QUEEN'S SPEECH AT THE MANSION

HOUSE .

"MY LORD MAYOR, I THANK YOU MOST WARMLY FOR THE WORDS IN WHICH YOU HAVE MADE US WELCOME AND FOR PROPOSING THIS TOAST, AND I THANK YOUR GUESTS FOR THE MANNER IN WHICH THEY HAVE RECEIVED IT.

FROM THE RESPONSE, I BELIEVE THAT THEY FEEL, AS L.

DO THE BEAL MEANING OF THIS OCCASION LIT IS TRUE THAT MY
HUSBAND AND I ARE HERE AT YOUR INVITATION TO MARK THE END OF
THE COMMONWEALTH JOURNEY WHICH HAS OCCUPIED US DAY AND NIGHT FOR

THE LAST SIX MONTHS.

"IT IS ALSO TRUE THAT WE ARE CELEBRATING OUR RETURN TO THIS CITY OF LONDON, WHOSE CITIZENS ONLY A FEW DAYS AGO GAVE US A WELCOME WHICH WARMED OUR HEARTS AND WHICH NEITHER OF US WILL EVER FORGET. BUT OVER AND ABOVE THAT WE MEET HERE -- AS WE UNDERSTAND IT-- TO DO HONOUR TO EACH AND EVERY PART OF THE BRITISH COMMONWEALTH AND EMPIRE. TODAY WE TURN OUR HEARTS AND MINDS BOTH TO THOSE LANDS WHICH WE HAVE VISITED AND ALSO TO THOSE WHICH WE HAVE ON THIS OCCASION BEEN UNABLE TO INCLUDE IN OUR TOUR. FOR WE FEEL THAT THEIR EYES ARE ON US AND THAT THEY WILL ALL HEAR OR READ OF WHAT IS NOW PASSING WITHIN THESE WALLS.

"FIRST, IT IS A PLEASURE TO ACKNOWLEDGE WITH DEEP GRATITUDE THE CARE OF THOSE WHO HAVE CARRIED US IN SAFETY FOR SO MANY MILES. THE OUTWARD AND PART OF THE RETURN JOURNEY FELL TO THE MERCHANT NAVY AND TO THE CIVIL AVIATION OF THE UNITED KINGDOM. IN AUSTRALIA AND NEW ZEALAND WE FLEW MANY THOUSANDS OF MILES IN CIVIL AND SERVICE AIRCRAFT AS WELL AS MAKING SEVERAL JOURNEYS BY TRAIN IN THESE COUNTRIES AND IN CEYLON. FROM MALTA WE SAILED HOME IN THE SPLENDID YACHT BRITANNIA, OF WHICH WE ARE BOTH SO PROUD. WE THANK ALL WHO HAVE BORNE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THESE TRAVELS.

"I AM GLAD, TOO, TO BE ABLE TO THANK ONCE AGAIN OUR
HOSTS ALL ROUND THE GLOBE FOR THE WAY IN WHICH THEY MADE OUR
VISITS TO THEM, SHORT THOUGH SOME OF THEM HAD TO BE, SO
ENTHRALLING AND SO AGREEABLE THEY AN THEIR REPRESENTATIVES
WHOM I AM SO GLAD TO SEE HERE TODAY, ALREADY KNOW THE TRUE
DEPTH OF OUR GRATLEBULG AT THIS PARTICULAR MOMENT I AM
ALSO THINKING OF MY FLOPLE AT LARGE—THE MEN, WOMEN AND
CHILDREN WHO BY THEIR KINDNESS HAVE MADE US REALISE BY ACTUAL
EXPERIENCE THE TRUTH OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL AXION THAT WE ARE AT
HOME IN EACH COUNTRY OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

"I CANNOT MENTION IN THE SCOPE OF THIS ADDRESS ALL THE WONDERFUL PLACES WHICH WE HAVE SEEN. INSTEAD I SHALL DESCRIBE SOME OF THE ASPECTS OF OUR JOURNEY WHICH STRUCK US MOST

FORCIBLY.

"AS OUR JOURNEY PROGRESSED SO WE CAME TO REALISE MORE AND MORE THAT THE PEOPLES OF THESE MANY LANDS HOLD IN COMMON CERTAIN VIEWS OF ESSENTIAL IMPORTANCE. THESE THEY HOLD IN SPITE OF THEIR IMMENSE DIVERSITY AND NOTWITHSTANDING THEIR INGRAINED AND MOST PRAISEWORTHY DETERMINATION TO CONDUCT THEIR AFFAIRS EACH IN THEIR OWN WAY. IN CLIMATE, RACE, RELIGION AND CUSTOMS THERE ARE ENORMOUS VARIATIONS.

"MOUNT COOK, AS IT APPEARED TO US SOARING AMONG THE SNOWS OF THE SOUTHERN ALPS OF NEW ZEALAND, IS BUT REMOTELY RELATED TO THE SCORCHED ROCKS OF ADEN OR TO THE JUNGLES OF CEYLON. IT IS A FAR CRY FROM SYDNEY HARBOUR TO THE SOURCES OF THE NILE AND TO EVERY ONE OF THESE GEOGRAPHICAL CONTRASTS THERE ARE CORRESPONDING CONTRASTS IN THE HABITS OF LIFE AND THOUGHT OF THE MEN AND WOMEN OF THESE DIVERSE LANDS. YET, IN THESE LANDS THEIR PEOPLES HOLD STRONGLY TO CERTAIN COMMON PRINCIPLES OF WHICH ALL OF THEM BELIEVE TO BE VITAL.

3.32 PM. ADD THE QUEEN'S SPEECH.

"IN ALL OF THEM, FOR EXAMPLE, THE IDEA OF A PAR-LIAMENTARY AND DEMOCRATIC FORM OF GOVERNMENT IS ACCEPTED AND RESPECTED. IT IS A FORM OF GOVERNMENT WHICH, WHETHER IT HAS ALREADY BEEN ATTAINED IN FULL OR NOT, IS ASSUMED, LIKE FREE-DOM OF SPEECH AND RELIGION, TO BE PART OF THE ULTIMATE HERITAGE OF EVERYONE OF MY PEOPLE. AT THE HEAD OF THIS SYSTEM STANDS THE SOVEREIGN, EITHER AS QUEEN OF EACH PARTICULAR COUNTRY OR AS HEAD OF THE COMMONWEALTH OR AS BOTH, AND I HAVE TRIED, AND I HOPE IN SOME MEASURE HAVE SUCCEEDED, TO GIVE OUTWARD EXPRESSION TO THIS ASPECT OF OUR UNION IN EACH CAPITAL WHERE WE HAVE RESTED.

"THE STRUCTURE AND FRAMEWORK OF CONSTITUTIONAL MONARCHY COULD EASILY STAND AS AN ARCHAIC AND MEANINGLESS SURVIVAL.
BUT WHEREVER WE HAVE BEEN, IN NEW ZEALAND, AUSTRALIA
AND CEYLON AND IN ALL THE COLONIAL TERRITORIES, WE HAVE RECEIVED VISIBLE AND AUDIBLE PROOF THAT IT IS REAL AND LIVING IN
THE HEARTS OF THE PEOPLE WHICH ARE ALIKE IN LOYALTY AND AFFECTION
TO THE THRONE.

"THIS, I AM CONVINCED, MEANS MUCH FOR EACH COUNTRY,
AND FOR THE COMMONWEALTH AS A WHOLE. CERTAINLY MY HUSBAND
AND I ARE GREATLY UPLIFTED IN KNOWING THAT SO MANY MILLIONS
OF MY PEOPLE SHARE THIS FEELING FOR US, JUST AS WE DERIVE
DAILY SUPPORT FROM THE KNOWLEDGE OF THE PRAYERS AND GOOD WISHES
WHICH, WHATEVER THEIR FAITH OR CREED, THEY OFFER ON OUR
BEHALF.

"THERE IS SOMETHING ELSE TO WHICH I WOULD DRAW YOUR ATTENTION BECAUSE I BELIEVE THAT IT IS NOT ALWAYS CLEARLY UNDERSTOOD BY MY PEOPLE IN THESE ISLANDS, PREOCCUPIED AS THEY WELL MAY BE BY THE DIFFICULTIES AND DANGERS OF THE WORLD IN WHICH WE ALL LIVE. I WANT TO REMIND YOU WITH ALL THE POWER AT MY COMMAND THAT YOU DO NOT STAND ALONE.

"YOUR EFFORTS DO NOT PASS UNNOTICED OR UNADMIRED; YOU DO NOT -- AND I KNOW YOU NEVER WILL-- LACK THE FRIENDLY COMRADESHIP OF THE OTHER NATIONS OF OUR COMMONWEALTH FAMILY. TO A VAST NUMBER OF THEIR PEOPLE THE WORD HOME MEANS THIS OLD LAND OF BRITAIN, FOR SO WE HAVE HEARD IT REFERRED TO AGAIN AND AGAIN IN THE LAST FEW MONTHS. OTHERS--THOUGH NOT THINKING OF THE UNITED KINGDOM AS HOME-- STILL LOOK TO HER AS THE ORIGIN OF A WAY OF LIFE WHICH THEY ADMIRE.

"BU CAN INDEED ASSURE YOU THAT TO ALL OF THEM THIS COUNTRY HOLDS A SPECIAL POSITION IN THE WORLD AND IN THEIR AFFEC-, TIONS. ON THIS TOUR AND ON PREVIOUS VISITS TO CANADA AND SOUTH AFRICA AS WELL, WE HAVE ALWAYS FOUND A DEEP ADMIRATION AND LOVE FOR BRITAIN AND FOR HER PEOPLE. HER EFFORTS TO RECOVER FROM THE WAR, HER EVERY ACHIEVEMENT OR REVERSE IS FOLLOWED WITH A CLOSE AND LIVELY INTEREST AND HER EXAMPLE IS AND ALWAYS WILL BE OF SUPREME IMPORTANCE. THIS WAS PROVED A HUNDRED TIMES IN WAR; WE HAVE SEEN THE TRUTH OF IT IN PEACE.

"MOREOVER, OUT OF 1T IS SPREADING SOMETHING NEW -SOMETHING WHICH HOLDS GREAT PROMISE FOR THE FUTURE. THERE IS A
KEEN AND GROWING SENSE OF INTERDEPENDENCE AMONG THE COMMONWEALTH
COUNTRIES AND COLONIAL TERRITORIES. ON THE DAY ON WHICH THE
BRITANNIA SAILED FROM MALTA A PARTY OF EMIGRANTS WAS ASSEMBLING
ON THE CUSTOMS HOUSE QUAY. THEIR NEW HOMES WILL BE IN AUSTRALIA
WHERE MANY OF THEIR COMPATRIOTS AWAIT THEM AND WHERE THEY WILL
LEND THEIR LABOURS TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE GREAT ISLAND CONTINENT. AT THE SAME TIME AUSTRALIAN AIRMEN ARE STATIONED IN
MALTA AS A PART OF THEIR NORMAL DUTIES.

"THIS IS A SMALL EXAMPLE, BUT FROM WHAT MY HUSBAND AND I HEARD IT IS ONLY ONE INDICATION NOT ONLY OF AN INCREASING DESIRE TO WORK TOGETHER WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH BUT OF A REALISATION OF THE PRACTICAL ADVANTAGES OF DOING SO. THERE IS CERTAINLY NOTHER ASSOCIATION IN THE WORLD WHICH OFFERS SO MANY OPPORTUNITIES FOR CO-OPERATION OR WHICH MAKES IT SO EASY FOR INDIVIDUAL MEN AND WOMEN TO MOVE ABOUT AND TO CHOOSE FREELY THEIR SURROUNDINGS, THEIR HOMES OR THEIR MANNER OF WORK.

"IF TIME ALLOWED THERE WOULD BE MUCH MORE OF WHICH I COULD WISH TO TELL OF THE CEASELESS ADVANCE IN SO MANY DIRECTIONS.

"THE THRIVING FARMS OF NEW ZEALAND AND THE METHODS BY WHICH THE VOLCANIC STEAM OF THAT COUNTRY IS BEING HARNESSED TO PROVIDE POWER FOR INDUSTRY; THE SCIENTIFIC AND AGRICULTURAL DEVELOPMENTS WHICH ARE GOING FORWARD IN AUSTRALIA AND, IN A DIFFERENT BUT TO ME NO LESS INTERESTING WAY, THE FLYING DOCTOR SERVICE BY WHICH LONELY FAMILIES OF THE OUTBACK ARE GIVEN MEDICAL HELP; THE ANCIENT TANKS IN CEYLON WHICH ARE BEING RESTORED TO IRRIGATE BARREN AREAS; ALL THIS AND MUCH ELSE TELLS A STORY WHICH EVERYONE WHO WISHES TO UNDERSTAND THE COMMONWEALTH SHOULD STUDY. NOR ARE THE COLONIAL TERRITORIES FALLING BEHIND. SEVEN YEARS AGO THE OWEN FALLS DAM, WHICH I OPENED AT THE END OF APRIL, ONLY EXISTED ON PAPER. TODAY THE ANCIENT NILE IS CONTROLLED AT ITS SOURCE. ITS POWER WILL ENRICH UGANDA AND ITS WATERS ARE TO BE HUSBANDED FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE FARMERS OF THE SUDAN AND OF EGYPT.

THE MINISTER OF LABOU*, SIR WALTER MONCKTON, MADE A STATEMENT ABOUT THE STRIKE OF THE FOOTPLATE MEN ON THE RAILWAYS, IN REPLY TO A PRIVATE NOTICE QUESTION BY MR GEORGE ISAACS (LAB SOUTHWARK)

HE SAID:" THE STRIKE OF LOCOMOTIVE DRIVERS AND FIREMEN IS IN PROTEST AGAINST THE INTRODUCTION OF ADDITION L LODGING TURNS. IT IS WHOLLY UNOFFICIAL AND IS CONFINED, SO FAR, TO PADDINGTON, BRISTOL, AND NEWTON ABBOT, IN THE WESTERN REGION OF BRITISH RAILWAYS.

ACCORDING TO MY LATEST INFORMATION, AT THESE PLACES 906 MEN HAVE FAILED TO REPORT FOR DUTY TO-DAY OUT OF A TOTAL OF 1,008.

"THIS HAS, OF COURSE, RESULTED IN SUBSTANTIAL INTER-FERENCE WITH PASSENGER AND FREIGHT TRAFFIC .

"THE LODGING TURNS NOW IN DISPUTE HAD ALREADY BEEN AGREED BETWEEN THE BRITISH TRANSPORT COMMISSION AND THE TRADE UNIONS CONCERNED THROUGH THE ESTABLISHED MACHINERY THE UNIONS HAVE URGED THEIR MEMBERS TO HONOUR THEIR OBLIGATIONS.
