Mademoiselle Genevieve de Calard only french nurse and woman who stayed all along the bitter Dien-Bien-Phu battle, and was then taken a prisonner by the Vist-Mink troops, has been released by Vist-Mink authorities and reached Hanoi last week.

Geneviève de Galard whose herois conduct with French and Vietnamian wounded in Dien-Bien-Phu had already received the award of the Legion of Honor and Har cross which were parachated in the last days of the battle, had also endured the entire battle 57 days under continual gunfire and battle hazards.

She is greeted at Hanoi on Bach Mai airport by Generals COCHY and DECHAU. General Dechau is Geneviève's direct commander in Chief as she is an Air Force Nurse, General Cogny is French commander in Chief in Northern Viet Nam. Upon her arrival, Geneviève de Galard is immediately surrounded by world pressmen but is wisked away by the Generals for a well carned rest. DECHAIT

Next day, under presidency of General Manny, Genevaève de Galard holds a press conference in the gardens of the NorthernViet-Nam ground forces att headquarters. She also had a long conference with General COCHY to give him details of the battle of Dien-Bien-Phu and what happened to General de Castries ... Geneviève de Calard is due in Paris on June Ist.
