The prototype Bristel Britannia is made ready at Filten for a sixteen hundred mile flight to Libra. Bristel's Chief Test Pilet Bill Pers will take the jet-pres airliner to Castel Idris for preliminary hotweather trials. B.O.A.C. technical experts and Air Registration Board officials travel with Pegg who, last Pebruary, when piloting a Britannia, made a brilliant emergency landing in the mad of the Severn estuary without easualty.

The Britannia sets course from Bristel for its first-ever overseas flight - to Libya, only four and a half flying hours away.
