BEITISH LEAVE TELESTE.

Her Majesty's aircraft earrier "Contaur" is at Trieste to aid in the evacuation of 3,000 British treeps from the port. These men, who include the Second Battalies Lonenshire Pusiliers and the Pirst Battalies the Loyals, are losving following the recent four-power agreement on the division of the territory between Italy and Yugoslawis. British and American treeps, under the command of Majer General Sir John Winterton, have guarded the sity for mine years.

Ab ut 300,000 people from Italy have come to Trieste to molecome the first Italian through into the city. 5,000 soldiers are greated with almost franzied enthusians as they move in at a given signal. Italy, however has not wen all her demands, and a small sirip of territory that was in dispute has been handed to Tageslavia. Under the new agreement, Italy has undertaken to maintain Trieste as a Free Port.

At last, after many tense years of wrangling, the division of Trieste has been agreed. The patience and impartiality of the British troops during their stay has contributed greatly to the final, peaceful outcome.
