TITO MEETS MASSER

On his way back to Yugoslavia, from his long journey in India, Marshall TITO, Yugoslav President of the Republic, arriving in SUEZ on board his private ship the "GALEB" stopped over in Suez for a talk and conference with Egyptian Prime Minister and President of the Revolutionary Council, Lt.Col. GAMAR ABDEL MASSER.

Col.MASSER, was greeted on board the "GALEB" by Marshall Tito himself, surrounded by Yugoslav officials. Col.MASSER was accompanied in his visit to Tito, by General Abdel Hakim Amer, Commander in Chief of Egyptian armed Forces, Lt.Colonel Zakaria Mokhammad, Interior Minister and Mahmoud Nawal Foreign Affairs Minister.

When boarding the "Galeb" Col.Masser and his host first reviewed the Honor Guard, then the high personalities retired in one of the Galeb's sumptuous rooms for a conference.

Along the Suez Canal the crowd had gathered to cheer the visitors, and observation posts of the Suez Canal Company were decorated with placards and slogans for the occasion.
