ROLL ONE -

Two captains - Denis Atkinson (West Indies) Ian Johnson (Australia) inspect the wicket and spin coin. Australia win toss and decide to bat. West Indies team poses for the press. Both teams presented to The Governor, Sir Hugh Foot. Umpires Tom Swart and Perry Burke - go out followed by West Indies team and Australian opening pair - McDonald and Morris. C.U's opening pair batting. Establishing shots of Frank King (pace) and Sonny Ramadhin (spinner) bowling at the opening pair.

ROLL TWO -

Further shots of players in action. First wicket falls - McDonald stumped Binner, bowled Valentine for 50. Including among these shots is a panoramic view of crowded pavillians with West Indies team coming on to field. Panoramic view of another section of pavillion with players in action in foreground.

ROLL ONE - ~~MEMO~~ EYEMO. 100 feet.

Cut away shots of crowd. West Indies captain examines wicket. Captains walk out to spin coin. Shot of coin being spun. West Indies team posed for press. H.E. Governor of Jamaica introduced to members of Australian team.

ROLL TWO EYEMO . 95 feet.

Long shot of pavillion. West Indies take the field. Another long shot of pavillion. Cut aways of the crowd.

ROLL THREE - 110 feet.

Neil Harvey and Keith Miller at bat against West Indian Bowlers. General crowd shots.
