HEW YORK BUILDING CALLAPSES:

At Columbus Circle, the Hyde Park Corner of New York, this was the scene after the cellapse of a whole floor of the unfinished Coliseum building. Rescue workers search among the debris for a victim still unaccounted for, in a crash which trapped and injured forty workmen.

A thousand men were at work on the 35,000,000 mellar structure when the floor collapsed, hurtling men, concrete, and steel twenty two feet to the street below.

The forty injured will all recover and only one man still has to be found in what eye-witnesses call the "miracle at Columbus Circle".
