**COLISEUM FLOOR COLLAPSES, --- SCORES HURT .**

**AT COLUMBUS CIRCLE, SCORES OF WORKMEN ARE TRAPPED IN THE HUGE SKELETON OF THE NEW YORK COLISEUM--- MOMENTS AFTER THE THUNDERING CAVE-IN OF AN UNFINISHED FLOOR. POLICEMEN, FIREMEN AND CONSTRUCTION CREWS---- WORKING WITH ACETYLENE TORCHES AND THEIR BARE HANDS--- CLAW FRANTICALLY THROUGH THE WRECKAGE FOR SURVIVORS.**

**ONE THOUSAND MEN WERE AT WORK ON THE THIRTY-FIVE MILLION DOLLAR STRUCTURE WHEN THE FLOOR OF THE MAIN EXHIBITION HALL COLLAPSED, HURTLING MEN, TIMBERS, CONCRETE AND STEEL TWENTY TWO FEET TO THE STREET IN A TERRIFYING TANGLE. DESPITE THE RUMBLING AVALANCHE OF DEBRIS, MOST OF THE WORKMEN ESCAPED. ONLY ONE IS UNACCOUNTED FOR AND FORTY INJURED --- NONE SERIOUSLY --- IN THE "MIRACLE AT COLUMBUS CIRCLE".**
