BILLY GRAHAM PACKS WEMBLEY.

At Wembley, the people of London and the Home Counties gather at the great Empire Stadium - to listen to Evangelist preacher Dr. Billy Graham. Indicative of a religious revival, they come in a constant stream.

In an atmosphere of worship and sincerity, the people hear a message of hope and faith in the future:

Almost bearing out these words, Vienna becomes the scene for Molotov and other foreign ministers to make a decisive move to lessen world tension. The Russian foreign minister has flown in to meet his Western opposite numbers at the Belvedere Palace and sign a treaty making Austria free. Mr. Harold Macmillan, signs for Britain.

M. Pinay signs for France.

Mr. Dulles signs for the United States of America - and the Treaty is complete. By December thirty-first all four countries' occupation forces will be out of Austria. There can be no doubt in Austrian minds that this is a step towards a real world peace!

Further eastwards we look to see what answers are provided in such meetings as this in Warsaw of all the Iron Curtain countries. Marshal Zukov leads the way into the Palace of Ministers.

Now arriving is Russian Prime Minister Marshal Bulganin - followed by Mr. Molotov.

Inside, the Russian Marshals Zukov and Koniev are greeted by Czechoslovakia's Minister of Defence. Formerly Minister of Justice, he is now also Deputy Prime Minister.

During the conference Marshal Bulganin talks of his government's "positive attitude" towards a Big Four meeting and on behalf of the Soviet Government he favours an ending of the cold war. Delegates from all the Communist Countries listen as Bulganin calls for a "real practical solution of the disarmament problem"

After 17 years - Austria is again Austria !

On the 13th of May 1955 America's foreign minister J.F. Dulles arrives at the airport of " TULLN ". A few hours later the foreign minister of Great Britain Harold Mc Millan arrives in " SCHECHAT " .

During the evening hours of the same day and on the same airfield the French foreign minister Antoine Pinay descends. On the 14th of May 1955 the foreign minister Wjatscheslav Molotov lands in " VOESLAU " near Vienna.

After a short conference the 4 foreign ministers ^{/agree} on the preliminaries of the Ambassadors' meeting.

And on Sunday, the 15th of May 1955, the treaty will be signed. Austria will again be is again-free and independent. For years our hopes had again and again been disappointed. Now they have been realized. 17 years ^{of} subjugation has ended.

The steadfastness, the democratic ideas and the will to live of the Austrian people and its government has conquered.

May the freedom she has obtained at long last be a signal for the world.
