And so he has, for after the first long set it's Trabert all the way. Now Trabert serves for match point - and wins.

Another great fifth-round tussle is between the big Swede, Sven Davidson - (that's him at the far end) and Australia's pocket dynamo Ken Rosewall. So one Commonwealth player at least, fights through to the semi-finals and a chance of the Cup.
