So it's Temy Trabert to meet Patty in the semi-final. Congresulations to an outstanding youngster - and also to a gallant and popular veteran.

Another great fifth-found tunsle is between the big Swede, Swen Davidson - (that's him at the far end) and Amstralia's pocket dyname Ken Resempll. Davidson is a powerful player at the not, but Ken has amazing variety. And by mutch point he has the Swede well and truly beaten.
