**DRUMMOND SLAYING CASE REOPENED**

**Dupenegative developed: 6 20 meters = 83 ft**

The old farmer Gaston Dominici who was sentenced to death for the slaying of the Drummonds (Sir Jack Drummond, Lady Drummond and their daughter Elizabeth) last year, never ceased to proclaim after the trial that he was innocent. His lawyers have ever since been pressing of public opinion for a new inquest, as they think there were mistakes or omissions in the first one made by the local police.

After several months, the Ministry of Interior and Justice has finally sent one of France's best Police Inspector, Mr. CHENEVIER, who, with his aids, Inspector Gillard and other has left Paris several days ago, and is beginning to go over the entire case on the spot in Lurs.

This coverage shows, the Paris Inspectors CHENEVIER, GILLARD etc... going over the murder site at Lurs, with the Gendarmerie Officer who made the first inquest immediately after the slaying occurred. They are listening to the Officer's explanations with photographs taken then, and the first files of documents. Many journalists and passers by are following them, and no one yet knows whether the entire case will finally, and full, establish the truth on this dramatic event.
