## PICKERING SIES CHANNEL PECOPD.

Last words of encouragement from world record holder Florence Chadwick, of America, go to Staffordshire swimming baths manager Bill Pickering at Dover before Bill's attempt to erack her Ingland to France channel record. On leave from his work at Blowrich, near Walsall, Bill propares for a "do-it-or-dic" attempt for he had been called back to work after waiting nearly a month for suitable conditions.

Mrs. Pickering watches as her humband's large frame is greased for the Channel Swim at St. Margaret's May. Big Bill was said to have swam with a chip on his shoulder about his summons back to work, but there is no sign of anger in these last minute scenes.

Wight has fallen before Bill enters the cold waters of the Channel for that ardness task which has defeated so many attempts. Only fourteen persons have over made a successful England to France swim.

Pushing his 18-stone untiringly forwards towards France, Bill gots constant encouragement from his father, who erossed in the pilot-boot.

Fourteen hours six minutes after entering the water Bill reaches land again. Finishing in great style, he has lapped 36 minutes off the record. The day before he said "I'll give them a swin for their memoy" referring to the people of Blownish who financed the channel bid. Not only Blownish now, but all Britain can be proud of the new record helder - Big Bill Pickeringi
