Prison comp conditions staged at a V.S. Air Perce school
near Reme, with the object of temphing airmon who may become prisoners of
war, have hit the world's headlines and started a floree controversy in the
American press; Interregators wear what are described as "hostile uniforms"
Third-degree questioning and "brain-making" are part of the course.

"The hole" is one of the terture devices installed to teach students to be ready for anything if they are exptured. The victim is put in melitary confinement, eight foot deep, and a trap-deer is closed on top of him.

The eremped "sweat-box" is another fixture of the camp, through which 29,000 V.S. airmon have passed. Now public criticism has raised the question: should the Air Force "soften ty" its tough school of marrival.
