

The Czechoslovak Newsreel Studio presents a short shot - This year's Pardubic Steeplechase. In this year's great Pardubic steeplechase have been a great number of horses from Czechoslovakia and the Soviet Union. Altogether there were twenty horses. The seven kilometre long track with thirty obstacles - the most difficult one on the Continent - has laid great demand on the horse as well as on the rider. The most dreaded Taxis trench, has even this year been disastrous for the starters. Only four horses have got over the Taxis trench without a fall. Another difficult obstacle has been the Irish bank. At the top has got the Soviet Stallion Nefrit before Furios and Brouk. Nefrit has kept the lead to the serpent trench, but here he was overtaken by Furios and some others. Many of the horses disliked the obstacles and all the efforts of the riders has been in vain. Only half of them ended to whole race. At the finish had Furios from the Slovakian stud-farm Topelcanky most of the strength together with the jockey Cajda and has won the great Pardubic steeplechase.
