Highlight of the visit of Soviet premier Bulganin and Party leader Khrushchev to Delhi is a mammoth civic reception at which over a million people gather to hear speeches from the Russian guests.

Marshal Bulganin tells the vast crowd of Russia's sympathy for India's efforts to develop her national economy. Russia, he says, is prepared to share with India information on problems of industrial development, including the use of atomic energy. So the struggle continues to win the friendship of the world's greatest neutral.

It's a real turf occasion when jockey Mandy Mercer gets married at Newmarket. His friend Doug Smith's children Michael and Wendy are the two youngest attendants of the bride.
