Over 3,000 scientists from various parts of India and foreign countries assembled in Agra to hold the Science Congress which was inaugurated by Prime Minister Nehru. It was biggest ever meeting of scientists in India and addressing them Mr. Nehru appealed them to face the social consequences of their achievements and to take an integral view of life and its problem. He further said to them that the scientists were the high priests of the modern age and their achievements dominated man's way of thinking. Continuing Mr. Nehru said that mankind was today alive to the dangers inherent in the use of, or experiments with, nuclear weapons, but the great source of danger was that Atom Bomb which men nursed in their hearts and mind. Perhaps that was the source of nuclear weapons, he said.
