DEMONSTRATION IN ALGERIA: The violent demonstration which took place, when M. Jacques Soustelle was leaving, is an indication of the deep uneasiness in Algeria.

The 60,000 to 100,000 people who demonstrated, will certainly welcome and respect the right Governor, but the far reaching effect of this manifestation, does not fit the frame of the ceremony.

The nervous tension of the French in Algeria has now reached new heights of exasperation. Nebody had foreseen ye stories this movement of such importance and vielence. With such alegans as "Soustelle with us" - "Don't leave us Soustells" - "Stay with us" - "With you we will remain French" and "To the Sea with Catroux", the demonstrators tried to prevent M. Soustelle's departure.

At the station, the Gare Maritime d'Alger, where more than 20,000 had gathered, the crowd got out of hand. As soon ashe left his car to review the Guard of Honour he was beasiged by the mass (students in particular) of cheering people, and the berriers were broken,

News was announced that M. Soustelle, Governor-General of Algeria, was to give up his post end wee to be succeeded by General Catrour whom the French government had appointed Minister-Resident in Algiam.

When the time came for M. Soustelle and his wife to leave Algiers for home they found a crowd of some 60,000 demonstrating at the landing-stage of the part. Breaking through the police cordon the demonstrators surrounded M. Soustalle cheering him on. To escape from this deligious "send-off", M. Soustelle climbed on to an armoured-par. There he stayed for an hour while police and troops were trying to elear a "gangway" for him across the surging crowd. To board the ship that was taking him home, M. Squatelle had to "jump for itt. The howling demonstrators stayed on chanting slegens and calling on the Governor-General not to go back to France
